ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to teams of four male amateur golfers who are members in good standing of the same OGA Member Club. Each OGA Member Club is limited to a maximum of 3 team entries. All contestants must be at least 13 years of age as of September 30, 2023.

FIELD LIMIT

The field is limited to 36 teams. Teams will be granted entry based on date and time of receipt of entry and entry fee. A club may enter up to three teams but additional teams will be put on a waiting list. After the September 13, 2023 closing deadline, all remaining spots will be filled from the waiting list. The waiting list teams will be granted entry based on date and time of receipt of entry and entry fee.

CLUBS MAY SUBMIT AN ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE WITH PLAYER NAMES TO BE DETERMINED AT A LATER DATE. All teams must submit player names to the OGA by September 13, 2023 or forfeit their entry.

ENTRY FEE

\$660 team entry fee must accompany entry form and will include three rounds of golf (one practice round and two competitive rounds) and tee prizes. Refunds are not available after the closing date of September 13, 2023, except for documented medical reasons. All refunds are subject to a \$20 administrative fee.

ENTRY DEADLINE

All entry forms must reach the OGA office by 5pm on September 13, 2023. Entries by telephone, FAX, or email must accompany payment. Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the OGA Staff establishes. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the OGA in order to submit a late entry.

FORMAT AND PRIZES

(GROSS PRIZES ONLY)

36-hole stroke play team competition. The low 3 of 4 individual gross scores each day will represent the team's aggregate. Special awards from Jones Sports Co. will be provided to the winning team. In addition, merchandise certificate awards will be given to top individual finishers. THERE WILL BE NO NET PRIZES.

EXEMPTIONS

The defending championship team, Columbia Edgewater CC, and any OGA Member Club that hosts a 2023 OGA Championship, USGA or OGA Qualifier, or Junior Amateur Championship is eligible for one guaranteed entry into the Championship. Exempt team players must meet the eligibility requirements and file an entry by the deadline.

STARTING TIMES & PRACTICE ROUNDS

Starting times, pairings for both rounds and practice round information will be forwarded to designated Team Captain.

TIES

In the event of a tie for the Team Championship, the unused individual's score of the final round will be counted. If teams are still tied, then the unused individual's score of the first round will be counted. Should the tie still exist, duplicate awards will be issued.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

Entrants who unofficially withdraw without an acceptable reason and without notifying the OGA will not be granted entry into any future OGA events for a minimum of one year.

CONDITIONS & SCHEDULES

The OGA assumes no liability for any conditions of the competition. Upon submitting this entry form and subsequently playing in this competition, players agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the OGA and its respective affiliates directors, officers, employees, agents, and assigns from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities and losses, including, without limitation reasonable attorney's fees and costs and expenses of litigation, arising out of any negligent act or omission of the indemnifying party in connection with the conditions herein. The Committee in charge of the competition reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Committee in any matter shall be final.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

The OGA will make every effort to complete the scheduled number of rounds of the tournament. As a general policy, in circumstances under which the final round is suspended due to inclement weather and it becomes impossible to complete the round on the same day: 1) If all players in the field/flight/ division have not completed at least 9 holes, the results of the Championship will be determined by reverting to the previous round's totals and the suspended round will be canceled, or 2) If all players have completed at least 9 holes of the final round, every effort will be made to finish the final round on the following day. All decisions to suspend or resume play will be at the discretion of the Committee. Any additional information regarding guidelines for suspensions and cancelations can be obtained by contacting the OGA.
