



2025 OGA Junior Golf – Residency Policy

OGA Junior Golf Membership is open to golfers older who are 8- 19 years old who are permanent residents of Oregon or SW Washington (which include areas within Clark, Skamania and Cowlitz counties). Golfers that are younger than the age of 8 years old or have matriculated will not be allowed to compete in OGA Junior Golf event.

Permanent residency is determined by the establishment of a domicile and predominant physical presence in Oregon or SW Washington for a period of 6 months or longer at the time of membership application submission. United States Citizenship or Non-United States Citizen Permanent Residence status is required. Golfers that do not meet the OGA Junior Golf Membership requirements may still be permitted to gain membership access if the golfer meets the age requirements and is residing with a guardian or family member that meets the permanent resident requirements during the months of June through August. Proof of residency may be required, and you may need to submit a copy of a government issued photograph identification and mail matching the address on the identification.

Failure to meet the residency requirement and/or submit acceptable documentation could result in the termination of the membership. A non-resident may participate in limited OGA Junior Golf activities. However, a non-resident will be not allowed to participate in any OGA Junior activities that would gain OGA Junior Golf Team Points, AJGA Stars, national ranking points, qualify into the IMG Junior World Championships, play in any OGA Junior Golf Open Division, and have entry priority in any division over an OGA Junior member.
